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Wine

Arrogant Frog Pinot Noir (Southern France)

Light and relaxed body expressing red berries, soft spices and a hint of vanilla

Grant Burge Merlot (Barossa Valley)

Cherry and red plum fruit flavours with a lingering milk chocolate finish. Very drinkable

Pepperjack Shiraz (Barossa Valley)

Red and blue fruits, dark chocolate and rich mocha notes with hints of spice and cedary oak

Pepperjack Cabernet Sauvignon (Barossa Valley)

Hearty blackberry and blueberry fruit flavours mixed with a hint of chocolate. Fine smooth tannins

Peter Yealands Pinot Gris (Marlborough)

Pear drop and nutty characters, subtle flavours of stone fruit and honey. Full palate balancing fruit sweetness and acidity

Squealing Pig Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough)

Bright and refreshing dry with layers of green pineapple and passionfruit, and a tangy citrus finish

Taylors Discoveries Chardonnay (Limestone Coast)

Dry but fresh, lifted aromas of peach and subtle tropical fruit characters along with touch of citrus for tight acidity with a clean finish

Brown Brothers Moscato (King Valley)

A sweet Aussie favourite. Spritzy on the palate with aromatic sherbert and tropical flavours

Scotch Whisky

Spey River 12 year old (Speyside)

Matured in Bourbon oak, offers soft notes of honey, buttery brioche, tropical fruit and citrus

Talisker Storm (Isle of Skye)

Smoke and peat from heavily charred oak casks, with salty, earthy and peppered spice flavours

Aberfeldy 12 year old (Highlands)

Super smooth for a 12yo, with notes of honey, heather and spice

Dalwhinnie Winters Gold (Highlands)

From the highest and coldest distillery, rich and sweet with subtle peat and a spicy warmth. Liquid gold

Cocktails

Espresso Martini

Flash brew Boss long black espresso, shaken on ice with Vodka and Kahlua

Moscow Mule

Double shot of vodka, mixed with ginger beer and lime, on ice

Black Russian

One part Kahlua, mixed with 2 parts vodka, shaken on ice

Classic Margarita

Double shot of tequila, with one Cointreau and lime, in a salt rim glass garnished with lime
